The Voices for Children / Court Appointed Special Advocate Program (CASA) is administered by Accord, a not-for-profit corporation whose principle place of business is 30 West State Street, Binghamton, NY 13901.

The CASA program provides trained volunteer advocates who are appointed by Family Court judges to particular child abuse and neglect cases. The advocate gathers information, submits written reports and attends hearings to aid the Family Court with its' decision making. Each advocate participates in training, which meets the criteria established by the National CASA Association.
